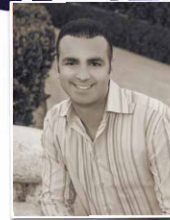

Dan Herdoon, a young member of the Iraqi Jewish community, is in need of a bone marrow transplant. No match has been found, as the Iraqi Jewish community is tremendously under-represented in the worldwide bone marrow registries. Adding 10,000 Iraqi Jews to the registry will triple the chance of someone in the community finding a match.

A simple cheek swab is all it takes to register. Once Dan's match is identified, the donation process is similar to giving blood, and by law that person's identity cannot be released unless they choose to do so after one year. Please urge your friends and family of Iraqi Jewish descent, especially young adults age 18-40, to attend the upcoming donor drive.

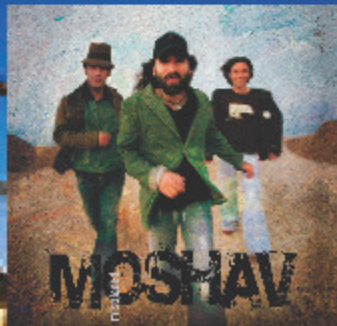
