A Sephardic Evening Under the Stars

Last month, Kahal Joseph hosted a concert of Selihot prayers in the Sephardic tradition incorporating melodies from Andalusia, Iraq, and other sites in the Sephardi-Mizrahi world. Numerous hazzanim, including our own Rabbi Hagay Batzri, regaled the audience with their pleasant voices and in-depth knowledge of Sephardic music and tradition.

Yesterday, I and many others made our way to a private home in Beverly Hills for another elegant Kahal Joseph event, organized by Rabbi Batzri and his wife, Orly. As we arrived, we heard the strains of amazing Spanish guitar music. Once there, we enjoyed a beautiful, festive setting with tables full of fruits, desserts and Sephardic delicacies prepared by Penina Solomon. I sat with Rabbi Batzri for a few moments to chat about this evening and about things in general.

L. Baruch: Is this the first time you have organized an event of this type?

Rabbi Batzri: Not exactly. Kahal Joseph organized an event like this around Hannuka last year with Elan Attias. We invited young singles and couples.

Sometimes we call our young singles events "Young Professionals" functions. Some people don't feel comfortable everywhere, and we wanted to create a pleasant atmosphere, an inviting setting that welcomes people with warmth, in the Sephardic tradition, with Jewish feeling.

We want to take Judaism and offer it as an opportunity, as an option. We need to ask ourselves, in what way are Jewish people supposed to be "a light to the nations"? How and in what way may we share our message and find opportunities to act as examples, to create positive change in the world?

We want to nurture and nourish the younger generation in our community. We want to see young people take the initiative together. As a first step we are putting together a committee of young people.

We are searching for volunteers and are looking for people with diverse skills useful in reaching out to the community to shape a new young adult group.

What we offer, and what we propose, is an authentic Judaism that is open-minded, current, and Orthodox. At our synagogue, we offer interesting speakers and music-filled programs.


